

## What are camperships?

Camperships are awarded every year to Scouts who could not attend a Chief Seattle council camp without financial assistance. Programs which are eligible for this are Boy Scout summer camp, Junior Leader Training, high adventure treks, Cub Scout day camp, Cub Scout summer camp and Cub Scout provisional day camp. Camperships are provided through donations by concerned community groups, individuals and memorial funds.

## The Application

This application is in two parts. Both must be completed. Please print or type the form.

Full camperships are seldom awarded (generally 1/2 of the camp fee or less). It is the hope of the campership committee that the Scout, his family and his Scout unit will work together to earn as much of the fee as possible. It is part of the Scouting ideal that boys earn their own way.
